Understandings and Objectives

Many technologies used in education have built-in accessibility and usability features allowing [remote] learners to have personalized experiences when engaging with content.



Understanding how to choose and create materials that allow these features to function increases productivity, decreases frustration, and provides the greatest opportunity to equitably meet the social, emotional and educational needs of each learner, including those with disabilities.
