

New Student Checklist

Step 1: College Admission and Financial Aid Application

Got to <https://laraec.org/college-resources/> Use the **CCC Apply** and **FAFSA** links to complete your college application and then the FAFSA application.

For students who are undocumented, complete the **application to the college** and then complete the **California Dream Act application**.

Within two (2) business days after application submission, a **Student ID Number** will be sent to the personal email address entered on the application. Once you receive the Student ID number, go to step 2.

Step 2: Access The Student Portal

Use your Student ID Number to create a user password to access the student portal at **mycollege.laccd.edu**

On the student portal, check **campus email messages** and complete items listed on your **To Do List**.

Step 3: Assessment, Orientation, and Counseling

Assessment – Based on the information provided on your college application, the system will recommend an appropriate English and Math level course for you to register. If you are concerned about your level of English or Math you should speak with a counselor about support options that are available to you.

Orientation – Complete the online orientation available on **mycollege.laccd.edu**

Counseling – **Visit academic counseling at your campus** to determine which classes to register for and **develop a personalized education plan**. In most cases, academic counseling can be reached online, in-person, or you can make an appointment. Locate academic counseling on your campus website.

Step 4 : Register for Classes

Log into **mycollege.laccd.edu** to register for classes. For assistance contact registration help or the welcome center on your campus.

Step 5 : Pay Fees

Your enrollment will be cancelled unless you make payments by the due date listed in your student portal.

All fees may be paid online in the student portal using a debit or credit card. You may also pay in-person at your college business office with cash, money order, and USD cashier's check.

Step 6: Explore Student Support Programs
